February 25 – Paddy Wales – Plan your resilient Garden in changing times

Paddy Wales is the author of Journeys Through the Garden (Whitecap). Her images and written articles appear in national and international publications including Gardening Life, Canadian Gardening, House & Home, Style at Home, Fine Gardening, Chatelaine, the New Twelve- Month Gardener, and many more. Marilyn currently looks after the Garden Center for the Abbotsford Buckerfield's store and is also a horticultural judge. She shares her knowledge through workshops and seminars for Buckerfield's throughout the year as well as speaking to Garden Clubs and groups on a variety of subjects.



April 29 – Alex Augustyniak – Year Round Gardening

Alex Augustyniak grew up on farm in Ontario, Canada and moved to BC in the 90's. The Gajewski farm was established in 1938 and lead by his amazing grand mother, Mary Gajewski. At the height of operations, the farm had just over 400 acres with various crops including 15 acres of tomatoes (under contract with Aylmer's), cash crops, cows, chickens, eggs (farm gate



sales), ducks, and rabbits plus a 1 acre veggie garden. Over the last 35+ years, Alex has been growing veggies, herbs and prolific weeds throughout Canada, at the home farm in Manitowaning, Ontario, Port Moody and in raised beds throughout BC. In 2014, Alex took on the role of GM of West Coast Seeds Ltd., a BC family owned seed company and has lead the efforts to continually help people grow their own food 12 months of the year. Alex is also the Treasurer, and a ornamentals Judge of All American Selections, an independent seed trial group.

May 27 – Donna Balzer – Improving your garden soil

Horticulturist, speaker and author, Donna Balzer, has a degree in Agriculture with a specialty in Horticulture. She has a YouTube channel, has hosted HGTV program, "Bugs and Blooms" for the past three years and is frequently a guest on CBC radio.
