- 1. NAME
  - i. "The Sechelt Garden Club" is a member of the BC Council of Garden Clubs.
  
- 2. AIMS
  - i. Stimulate an interest in environmentally friendly gardening.
  - ii. Facilitate a forum for the exchange of plants and ideas.
  - iii. Assist members to understand and improve their gardening methods.
  - iv. Foster gardening interest in the community.
  - v. Provide ongoing horticultural education.
  
- 3. PRINCIPLES
  - i. The Club will conduct its affairs according to the Club's By-laws and all meetings will be guided by Robert's Rules.
  
- 4. AMENDMENT
  - i. The Constitution shall be reviewed every five years.
  - ii. Executive members may submit amendments in writing.
  - iii. Sufficient notice of an amendment shall include publication of the amendment in the Newsletter prior to the meeting at which the notice is given.
  - iv. The vote shall be taken at the next meeting. A two-thirds majority of members present is required for approval.
