Evergreen Huckleberry

Vaccinium ovatum



Evergreen huckleberry is a handsome BC native shrub that has small ovate glossy foliage. The foliage is tinted with red when young, maturing to dark green. Flowers are white-pink and bell-shaped in the spring followed by small purplish-black berries in the fall.

Evergreen huckleberry grows slowly to 2 m high and 1.5 m wide, it grows higher in the shade, up to 4 m. It is drought tolerant, fire smart and pollinator friendly. It prefers dry or occasionally moist conditions.

In the landscape; Evergreen Huckleberry is very versatile. It will form an attractive hedge given time but does not transplant well.
